Maison Patrimoniale Louis S.-St-Laurent Heritage House in Quebec.



Planning a HVAC system for a Heritage home can be a difficult task. One of the major considerations is to maintain the original structure, a task that is almost impossible when considering ducted units or chilled water systems. This made the Mitsubishi Electric City Multi system the ideal selection for the task. The City Multi system requires only two small diameter pipes to couple multiple indoor units to one VRF (variable refrigerant flow) condensing unit. This feature made it possible to install multiple wall mounted indoor units without changing the structure of the building. The PKFY type indoor units used for this project offer the quietest operation imaginable and creates unnoticeable whisper quiet comfort in this beautiful building.
